The discography of Spanish recording artist Aitana consists of four studio albums, one soundtrack album, one compilation album, one extended play, thirty-five singles, and nine promotional singles.

Throughout her career, Aitana's has accumulated a total amount of four number ones, twenty top 10 hits and 60 songs debut on the charts.

Her first professionally released single «Lo malo», a collaboration with fellow singer Ana Guerra became a major chart success in Spain, reaching number one and appearing as well in some other charts across the globe as Venezuela or Ecuador. Aitana's debut solo single «Teléfono» became the singer's breakthrough hit, debuting atop the PROMUSICAE Top 100 chart. Following single «Vas a quedarte» debuted atop the chart as well. Becoming the first single to archived a three number one strike on the country since the Top 100 is published. Following singles from her debut studio album Spoiler (2019) would reach the top 10 as well.

## Livin' la Vida Loca

"Livin' la Vida Loca" (transl. "Livin' the Crazy Life") is a song recorded by Puerto Rican singer Ricky Martin for his fifth studio album and English-language debut, Ricky Martin (1999). The song was written by Draco

Rosa and Desmond Child, while the production was handled by the latter. It was released to radio stations by Columbia Records as the lead single from the album on March 27, 1999. A Latin pop and dance song with elements of salsa, surf, and ska, it is about an irresistible, particularly sinister, wild woman who lives on the edge, seducing others into her crazy world. The song received acclaim from music critics, who complimented its lyrics and danceable rhythm. It was ranked as the best 1990s pop song by *Elle*, and was listed among the Best Latin Songs of All Time by *Billboard*.

"*Livin' la Vida Loca*" was also commercially successful, reaching number one in more than 20 countries. It is considered to be Martin's biggest hit and one of the best-selling singles of all time. In the United States, it topped the *Billboard* Hot 100 chart for five consecutive weeks, becoming Martin's first number-one single on the chart. Additionally, it broke several records on *Billboard* charts. It also spent eight consecutive weeks atop the Canada's RPM 100 Hit Tracks chart and topped the country's year-end chart. In the United Kingdom, it debuted at number one and stayed there for three weeks, making Martin the first Puerto Rican artist in history to hit number one. It has received several certifications, including double platinum in the UK. The track was nominated for Record of the Year, Song of the Year, Best Male Pop Vocal Performance, and Best Instrumental Arrangement Accompanying Vocalist(s) at the 42nd Annual Grammy Awards.

The accompanying music video was directed by American director Wayne Isham and filmed in Los Angeles, California. It received a number of awards and nominations. At the 1999 MTV Video Music Awards, it won a total of five awards and was nominated for several other categories, including Video of the Year, making Martin the first Latin artist in history to receive a nomination in this category. A Spanish-language version of "*Livin' la Vida Loca*" was recorded under the same title and reached the summit of the *Billboard* Hot Latin Tracks chart in the United States. To promote the original version of the song, Martin performed it on many television programs and award shows, including the MTV Video Music Awards and the World Music Awards in 1999. It is generally seen as the song that began the "Latin pop explosion" and paved the way for a large number of other Latin artists such as Jennifer Lopez, Shakira, Christina Aguilera, Marc Anthony, Santana, and Enrique Iglesias. Many bands and singers covered the song, and it has been featured in several films and video games.

Gloria Estefan is a Cuban-American singer-songwriter who has achieved various nominations and awards in her multi-decades career. With 100 million records sold, she was the all-time best-selling Latina singer and remains as one of the best-selling music artists of all-time.

She has won four Grammy Awards from 12 nominations, four Latin Grammy Awards from 7 nominations, several BMI Awards and *Billboard* Latin Music Awards among others. Gloria became the first Latin woman to receive Songwriter of the Year by BMI Awards in 1991. Her contributions and success have been recognized by various organizations, including an Icon Award by the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) in 2023.

Some awards were bestowed to both Emilio and Gloria Estefan. The Estefans have worked together since 1975 when they formed Miami Sound Machine, with Gloria as lead vocalist and Emilio handling the production. Since that time their scope has broadened, including Gloria's solo career. They received highest honors for civilians including a Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2019—highest U.S. civil award—becoming the first couple to receive the award. They also became the first marriage and first Hispanics to receive the Library of Congress Gershwin Prize for Popular Song in 2019. The inaugural Variety's Miami Entertainment Town Gala in 2022, honored the couple with The Legends and Groundbreakers Award recognizing them as Miami's "most notable musical pioneers" who "helped put Miami on the map with the revolutionary stylings of their Miami Sound Machine".

Gloria has been recognized for her charitable endeavours, winning the inaugurals Spirit of Love Award in 1991 (Ronald MacDonald), Alexis de Tocqueville Award in 1993 (United Way), and the Spirit of Hope Award in 1996 (Billboard Latin Music Awards). She is also the first woman to be named Person of the Year by the Latin Recording Academy in 2008. In addition, Gloria has been admitted into multiple Halls and Walk of Fames, including being the first Latina inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame. She has also obtained a number of honorary degrees in various institutions, including the University of Miami, Barry University and Berklee College of Music.

Justin Rafael Quiles Rivera (born March 29, 1990) is an American singer. He specializes in reggaeton, although his repertoire also includes genres such as Latin pop and Latin trap.

Quiles has been nominated for Premios Juventud. Besides writing his own songs, Quiles has written for his colleagues, most notably "Pierde Los Modales", by J Balvin feat. Daddy Yankee, "Take It Off", by Lil Jon feat. Yandel & Becky G, "Recuérdame", by Maluma, "Loba" and "Mi Nena", by Yandel, "Downtown" by Anitta feat. J Balvin and "Bichota", by Karol G where he also did backing vocals.

Since August 2013, Quiles has been signed to record label Rich Music. In February 2017, Rich Music and Quiles signed a distribution deal with Warner Music's Latin division.

Puerto Rican recording artist and actor Ricky Martin is the recipient of multiple awards and nominations since his solo debut in the 1990s. Known as the "King of Latin Pop", he is the all-time best-selling Puerto Rican's artist, and one of the best-selling Latino singers.

A former member of juvenile band Menudo (1984–1989), Ricky Martin achieved his first awards and nominations as a soloist at the very beginning of his career; he won El Heraldo de México Awards for his acting in the telenovela, *Alcanzar una estrella* (1990) and the film *Más Que Alcanzar una Estrella* (1992). Upon the release of his debut album, *Ricky Martin* (1991) and the following record, *Me Amaras* (1992), he achieved nominations at the international level, including *Lo Nuestro* Awards and *Billboard Music Awards*. He consolidated his career in late 1990s, with the albums *Vuelve* (1998) and *Ricky Martin* (1999), and the singles "María" (1995), "The Cup of Life" (1998), and "Livin' la Vida Loca" (1999), for which he garnered other major awards and nominations, including *Grammy Awards*, *BMI Latin Awards* and *Latin Billboard Music Awards*.

Ricky's career was recognized in various ceremony awards, including a *ALMA's Vanguard Award* (2002), a *Star Award* at the *Latin Billboard Music Awards* (2003), and *Lo Nuestro's Excellence Award* (2004) and *Maximum Excellence Award* (2008). In addition, his success was particularly recognized by others special recognitions, including *Premios Amigo's Latino Artist with the Greatest International Impact Award* (1997), *China Music Awards's Asian Most Influential International Artist Award* (2014) and various *Telehit Awards' Most Important Latin Artist Award*.

Outside of his work in music, Ricky Martin garnered a number of awards and nominations for his acting career in Hollywood's cinema and theater, including *Primetime Emmy Awards*. He also received recognitions for his hispanidad and his prominence as a renowned Puerto Rican entertainer. His charitable endeavors were also recognized by various organizations, including *amfAR* and the *World Summit of Nobel Peace Laureates*.

"Vente Pa' Ca" (transl. "Come Over Here") is a song recorded by Puerto Rican singer Ricky Martin, featuring a guest appearance from Colombian singer Maluma. It was co-written by Ricky Martin, Maluma, Nermin Harambašić, Anne Judith Wik, Ronny Svendsen, Carl Ryden, CheifOne, Mau y Ricky and Justin Stein, while the production was handled by Alexander Castillo. The song was released for digital download and streaming as a single by Sony Music Latin on September 23, 2016. It is a Spanish language reggaeton and pop song, and it contains various sexual innuendos. The song received widely positive reviews from music critics, who complimented its danceable rhythm and fusion of genres. It was ranked as one of the best Latin songs of the year by multiple publications, including The Guardian.

The song was nominated for the awards of Record of the Year and Song of the Year at the 18th Annual Latin Grammy Awards. "Vente Pa' Ca" was one of the most commercially successful Spanish-language songs of 2016, reaching number one in seven countries, including Argentina and Mexico, as well as the top five in Spain and on the Billboard Hot Latin Songs chart in the United States. It also reached the summit of the Billboard Latin Airplay, Latin Pop Airplay, and Tropical Airplay charts. Additionally, it was ranked among the top 10 best performing songs of 2017 in six Latin American countries. The song has received several certifications, including quadruple platinum in Spain.

An accompanying music video, released simultaneously with the song, was directed by Jessy Terrero and filmed at the SLS South Beach Hotel in Miami Beach, Florida. It depicts several parties in different locations in the hotel and has received over 1.8 billion views on YouTube. To promote "Vente Pa' Ca", Martin and Maluma performed it on several television programs and award shows, including both the Premio Lo Nuestro and the Premios Juventud in 2017. Multiple contestants on various music talent shows have covered the song, including Patricia Manterola and Máxim Huerta. Several remixes and other versions have accompanied the song, such as English versions featuring Delta Goodrem, and Wendy of Red Velvet. The latter reached number one on Melon's international music chart.
