Shia Saide LaBeouf ( SHY-? l?-BUF; born June 11, 1986) is an American actor and filmmaker. He played Louis Stevens in the Disney Channel series *Even Stevens*, a role for which he received Young Artist Award nominations in 2001 and 2002 and won a Daytime Emmy Award in 2003. He made his film debut in *The Christmas Path* (1998). In 2004, he made his directorial debut with the short film *Let's Love Hate* and later directed a short film titled *Maniac* (2011), starring American rappers Cage and Kid Cudi.

In 2007, LaBeouf starred in the commercially successful films *Disturbia* and *Surf's Up*. From 2007 to 2011, LaBeouf starred in the film *Transformers* and its sequels *Transformers: Revenge of the Fallen* and *Transformers: Dark of the Moon*, playing protagonist Sam Witwicky. The three films were commercially successful. In 2008, he played Henry "Mutt Williams" Jones III in *Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull*.

His other credits include the films *Holes* (2003), *Constantine* (2005), *Wall Street: Money Never Sleeps* (2010), *Lawless* (2012), *The Company You Keep* (2012), *Nymphomaniac* (2013), *Charlie Countryman* (2013), *Fury* (2014), *American Honey* (2016), *Borg vs McEnroe* (2017), *Honey Boy* (2019), *The Peanut Butter Falcon* (2019), *Pieces of a Woman* (2020), and *Padre Pio* (2022).

Since 2014, LaBeouf has pursued a variety of public performance art projects with LaBeouf, Rönkkö & Turner.

Brigitte Lin Ching-hsia (Chinese: 林青霞; pinyin: Lín Qīngxiá; born 3 November 1954) is a Taiwanese actress. Regarded as a screen icon, Lin played a key role in boosting Taiwan's film production with her romantic heroine roles in the 1970s before transitioning to Hong Kong, where she achieved great success with her androgynous roles in wuxia films. Following her marriage in 1994, she retired from acting and transitioned to writing in the 2000s, publishing four essay collections. In 2023, she received the Lifetime Achievement Award at the 60th Golden Horse Awards.

Clevandodendron

*Clevandodendron* is an extinct genus of lycopsid known from a single specimen from the Cleveland Shale. The only known specimen is significant because it preserves the complete plant from the basal portion, featuring thick appendages at one end, to near the shoot apex. The stem, which is 2 cm wide along most of its length, bears a terminal ovoid bisporangiate strobilus at the end which is similar to those of some *Lepidodendrales*. The early occurrence of *Clevandodendron* demonstrates that slender, unbranched lycopsids with an isoetalean plant habit existed as early as the upper Devonian and that diversification of the order may have been well established before the Carboniferous.

The PRC, amid the height of the Cultural Revolution, boycotted the Olympics due to the ROC participation under the name "Republic of China". 21 competitors, 15 men and 6 women, took part in 41 events in 10 sports.

Kiari Kendrell Cephus (born December 14, 1991), known professionally as Offset, is an American rapper. He rose to prominence as one third of the Atlanta-based hip-hop trio Migos. Formed with fellow rappers Quavo and Takeoff in 2008, the group released four commercially successful studio albums—Yung Rich Nation (2015), Culture (2017), Culture II (2018) and Culture III (2021)—before disbanding in 2023.

As a solo act, he first released the collaborative album *Without Warning* (2017) with record producer Metro Boomin and fellow Georgia-based rapper 21 Savage. It peaked within the top ten of the *Billboard* 200 and spawned the single "Ric Flair Drip," which peaked at number 13 on the *Billboard* Hot 100. He then guest appeared on Tyga's 2018 single "Taste", which became his first top ten hit on the latter chart as a soloist and helped Tyga achieve his first top 10 on the *billboard* charts in 4 years, and received diamond certification by the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA). That same year, he appeared alongside Travis Scott on Kodak Black's single "Zeze", which peaked at number two on the chart.

Offset signed with Motown and Capitol Records to release his debut solo album, *Father of 4* (2019). A commercial success, the album matched *Without Warning* on the *Billboard* 200 and spawned the top 40 single "Clout" (featuring Cardi B), which was nominated for Best Rap Performance at the 62nd Annual Grammy Awards. Offset and Cardi B's 2023 follow-up single, "Jealousy", peaked at number 55 on the *Billboard* Hot 100 and served as lead single for his second studio album *Set It Off* (2023), which released in October of that year to similar success. His 2025 single, "Bodies" (featuring JID), peaked at number 73 on the *Billboard* Hot 100 and preceded his third album, *Kiari* (2025).

His marriage to fellow rapper Cardi B—with whom he has three children—has been heavily publicized; the couple separated in late 2023, filing for divorce in August 2024.

Punctuation marks are marks indicating how a piece of written text should be read (silently or aloud) and, consequently, understood. The oldest known examples of punctuation marks were found in the Mesha Stele from the 9th century BC, consisting of points between the words and horizontal strokes between sections. The alphabet-based writing began with no spaces, no capitalization, no vowels (see abjad), and with only a few punctuation marks, as it was mostly aimed at recording business transactions. Only with the Greek playwrights (such as Euripides and Aristophanes) did the ends of sentences begin to be marked to help actors know when to make a pause during performances. Punctuation includes space between words and both obsolete and modern signs.

By the 19th century, grammarians explained the difference between the punctuation marks by means of a hierarchy that ascribed different weight to them. Six marks, proposed in 1966 by the French author Hervé Bazin, could be seen as predecessors of emoticons and emojis.

In rare cases, the meaning of a text can be changed substantially by using different punctuation, such as in "woman, without her man, is nothing" (emphasizing the importance of men to women), contrasted with "woman: without her, man is nothing" (emphasizing the importance of women to men). Similar changes in meaning can be achieved in spoken forms of most languages by using elements of speech such as suprasegmentals. The rules of punctuation vary with the language, location, register, and time. In online chat and text messages, punctuation is used tachygraphically, especially among younger users.

It is dated to the 2nd century BCE.
